

CKS™ — Chemical Kinetics Simulator 1.01

The Chemical Kinetics Simulator™ (CKS) program is a scientific software tool developed by chemists at IBM's Almaden Research Center. It provides the bench scientist with an easy-to-use, rapid, interactive method for the accurate simulation of chemical reactions.

At present, CKS™ is available for the Apple Power Macintosh, and PowerMac compatibles, as well as IBM OS/2 and Microsoft Windows 3.1/Windows95/Windows NT. We haven't found a UNIX compatible version and thus it doesn't run on Athena.

Using the program is pretty intuitive and a manual can be downloaded from IBM.
